WHO

- UK-based biscuit manufacturer
- 5 companies within the company's group
- Circa 900 users

CHALLENGE

- Number of acquisitions over the years had resulted in disparate systems across group
- Desired consolidation of systems in order to work under a single platform
- Exploration of cloud and moving workloads into Microsoft Azure
- Required a flexible and scalable solution should more users need to be supported as a result of further acquisitions

SOLUTION

- Servium called upon to evaluate implications of transitioning workloads to Azure or keeping everything on-premises
- Worked closely with Azure specialist to compile business case for cloud versus on-premises solution

- Staged migration to Azure, moving appropriate apps and services over 3 - 4 years
- Migration started with DR solution
