Frequently Asked Questions

Windows 7 is shortly going end of life. We know this change can be difficult, so we are here to help you with recommendations for what to do next and to answer some of the nagging questions you may have about the end of support.

Will my Windows 7 computer stop working on 14 January 2020?

No. Support for Windows 7 will be discontinued, but the software will continue to function. After 14 January 2020, if your computer is running Windows 7, it will no longer receive security updates. Therefore, it's important that you move to a modern operating system such as Windows 10, which can provide the latest security updates to help keep you and your data safe. In addition, Microsoft customer service will no longer be available to provide Windows 7 technical support.

How do I get Windows 10?

You can upgrade an existing PC to Windows 10, however, PCs have changed substantially since Windows 7 was first released ten years ago. Today's computers are faster, more powerful, and sleeker plus they come with Windows 10 already installed!

Can I upgrade Windows 7 to Windows 10 for free?

There was a promotional free upgrade offer available when Windows 10 first released, but that offer expired on 29 July 2016.

You can purchase and download Windows 10 on your device today. However, if your computer is more than three years old, it might be time to consider upgrading to a new device. We would love to help you find a computer that's faster, safer, and delivers the new features Windows 10 has to offer before your current PC slows you down.

How do I transfer my personal files to a new computer?

How do I sign into Windows 10 without a password?

Unlock your Windows 10 device with our password-free sign-in capability, Windows Hello. Use your face, fingerprint, or companion device to unlock your Windows 10 computer in the fastest, most secure way. On devices that support Windows Hello, users can automatically bypass the login screen without typing a password.
